Program Overview

The LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE program was developed over 22 years ago by the Missouri Chamber Foundation to engage Missouri high school students in hands on, real world leadership training. Now for four days each June, Missouri's brightest high school freshmen and sophomore student leaders come together to learn the characteristics and tools that tomorrow's leaders need to meet the challenges of an ever changing world. LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE has become of the state's premier leadership immersion programs.

One of the key components to the success of LEADERSHIP IN PRACTICE is the advanced concepts and theories of leadership and entrepreneurship that students are introduced to during the program. Students are introduced to content straight from top tier MBA and professional leadership development programs. Broken down in digestible segments, students learn about the basic four frameworks of leadership- Political leadership, Structural leadership, Symbolic leadership and Human Resource leadership. They also learn the ethical decision making process, key principles of entrepreneurship and innovative thought process, global leadership via a mock Model UN Session, 21st century skills and many other advanced leadership concepts.

Application requirements:

- ✓ Applications must be submitted between by March 1, 2019 with the \$25 application fee
- ✓ Students must currently be enrolled in the 9th or 10th grade
- ✓ Students must exhibit character, scholarship and leadership in the school and community, or have the potential to lead
- ✓ Students must have a letter of support from a superintendent, principal, counselor, teacher, coach, or a business /civic leader
- ✓ Up to 8 students may come from one high school

Selection process:

- Leadership attendees will be selected at the close of the application period
- Students will be notified via email by April 1, 2019
- Students must confirm attendance by May 1, 2019

Cost of the program:

- \$250 covers all direct costs related to the leadership forum including the application fee, housing, meals and materials

Housing and Meals:

- Attendees will be housed in student dormitories
- All meals will be provided
- A concession area will be available during certain times throughout the camp

Mentoring and Supervision:

- Senior counselors are onsite 24 hours for the full program and are comprised of business, education and nonprofit professionals
- Junior counselors serve as peer mentors and are assigned to each student group to help provide guidance and support
